

2011 RULES

1. The historical Tros Marets climb is open to all vehicles (licensed or otherwise) which are at least 35 years ago (from 31/12/1975). For exceptional vehicles, the selection committee will decide accordingly.
2. The historic climb is to be considered a demonstration allowing participants the freedom to drive at their own speed. Each participant shall drive according to their own possibilities, in safety and on a road closed to traffic. Consequently, there will be no timing or ranking.
3. A timed category will be offered in line with FIVA rules.
4. For licensed vehicles, drivers will have the possibility to follow the route signposted "Malmedy", the historic climb making up part of the route. Route 1 via Hockay: 21km, route 2 in the direction of Ovifat: 18 km.
5. Length of the hill climb: 4km.
6. Entrants will be limited to 80 vehicles. Vehicles will start at 40 second intervals.
7. Vehicles must comply with their original specifications and/or their homologation.
8. Drivers are obliged to wear a helmet.
9. Drivers must be at least 18 years old and must hold a valid driving licence.
10. The number of climbs is limited to 7 over the two days.
11. Licensed vehicles using open roads must be insured and must comply with the Highway Code.
12. Two recent good quality colour photos, both different and one of which must be $\frac{3}{4}$ on, are to be provided to the selection committee (FIA or FIVA documents accepted).
13. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any inscription without providing justification, notably for questions of quality or diversity of the line-up.
14. Should participants withdraw after June 20th, then their entrance fee will not be reimbursed.
15. Should places remain available, then inscriptions with an increased entrance fee will be accepted after June 20th.
16. Incomplete dossiers will not be accepted.
17. The rules for the "historic time-trial" will be made available at the end of 2010.

ENTRANCE FEE:

The entrance fee is 195 Euros (or 245 Euros after June 20th).

This includes:

- Organisation of the event and safety measures
- Dinner on Saturday night for one person (supplement for each additional guest: 40 Euros)
- as well as your secured place on the Grand-Place of Malmedy
- Souvenirs and presents.

MOTORBIKES AND SIDE-CARS

- Rules for cars apply. Demonstration event only.
- Number of motorbikes and side-cars limited to 30.
- Entrance fee until 20th June: 90 Euros.
- Entrance fee after 20th June increased by 50 Euros.
- Climbs only take place on Saturday.
